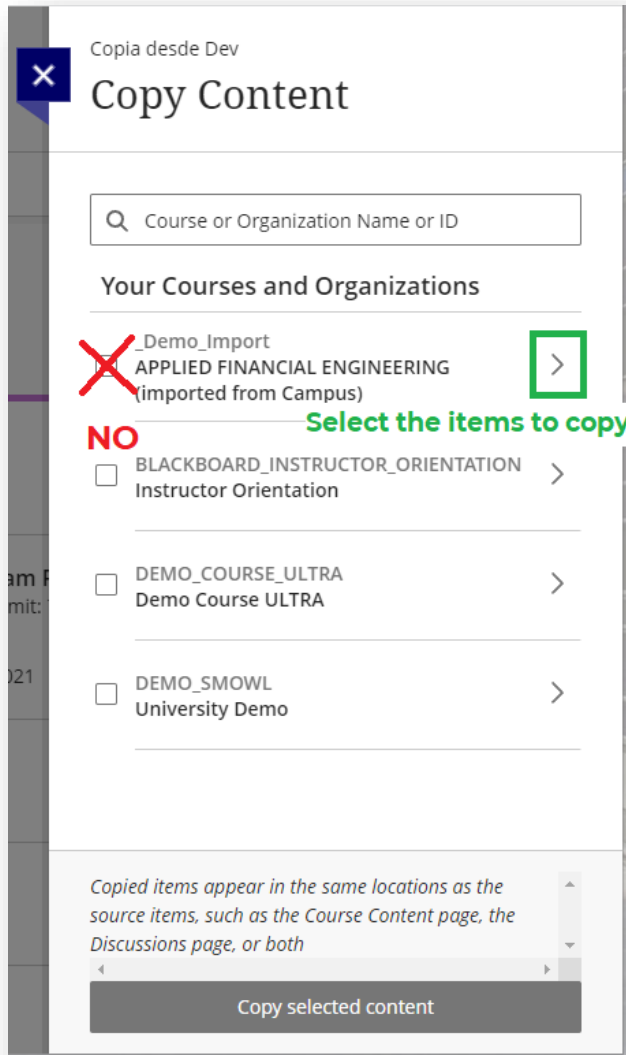


HOW TO: Copy content from other courses

You can copy all the content or select individual items from the other Ultra courses you teach.

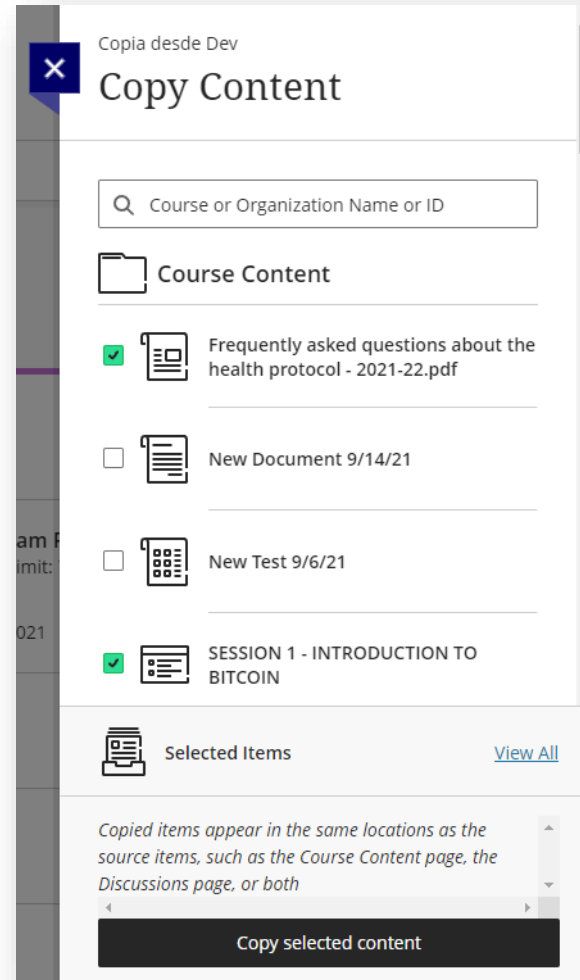
- On the Course Content page, select the plus sign to open the menu.
- Select Copy Content.
- The Copy Content panel opens.

After you make your selections, select Copy Selected Content to begin the copy action.
The copied content is added to the end of the content list.
